

JFS Food Pantry Guidelines

The Raleigh-Cary JFS Food Pantry is the only kosher food pantry serving Wake County and surrounding areas. The food pantry is located inside the JFS office at 8210 Creedmoor Rd. Ste. 104, in Raleigh.

Below you will find basic information about the JFS Food Pantry:

- The JFS Food Pantry is donation based. An updated list of accepted items is located on our [JFS Wish List](#) website and the [JFS Amazon Wish List](#) site.
- Donations are accepted at participating donation locations and anytime at the JFS office in a collection bin located just outside the office entrance.
- Both kosher and kosher-style, non-perishable items are distributed to families and individuals who currently receive services from JFS.
 - We do not distribute pork or shellfish products.
- Clients can pick up on Fridays during food pantry pick up hours or can request volunteer delivery of food pantry bags during the same hours.
- JFS Volunteers come to the office on Thursdays to pack needed food pantry bags that will be delivered the following day. Specific packing instructions are given upon arrival.

Before you join us at the office, please familiarize yourself with the following guidelines:

- All *in-person* volunteers must be fully vaccinated and are asked to provide a proof of vaccination to be kept on file

- In indoor locations face coverings and social distancing of at least 3ft are required, regardless of vaccination status. This is to protect JFS staff and the volunteer.
(Masks are available at the JFS office upon request)
- No volunteer may enter the JFS office if diagnosed with COVID-19 or if experiencing symptoms or if recently exposed to COVID-19.
- Volunteers coming in to the JFS office will sign in when entering the building to ensure we have proper records if a need for contact tracing arises.
