

Sliding Scale Fees and Fee Agreement - Effective July 2020

Raleigh-Cary JFS provides services on a sliding scale fee that is based on annual income and the size of household. While JFS expects to receive fair payment, services will not be withheld due to inability to pay. Client fees may be re-evaluated periodically to reflect changing circumstances. 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Description of Services:

<u>Initial telephone consultation (up to 30 minutes):</u> The phone consultation is usually the first contact a client makes with the JFS social worker. During this intake, the social worker collects basic information in order to understand current needs and concerns. The social worker will then direct the client and discuss appropriate services at JFS, provide community resources or refer to services at a different agency, if needed.

<u>Clinical psychosocial assessment (60 to 90 minutes)</u>: This is an evaluation of mental, physical and emotional health that provides a comprehensive picture of the client's current needs. The assessment includes pertinent information regarding the client's life, such as educational, vocational and social history and functioning, living situation and support systems, strengths and challenges, etc.

<u>Clinical counseling/therapy session (50 minutes)</u>: The therapist and client will agree and set goals for therapy and decide on the frequency of therapy sessions, according to the identified needs and goals. Using a wide range of therapeutic methods, we will meet for 50-minute sessions to achieve your goals.
